Our Patron

Saint Francis Xavier (April 07, 1506- December 02, 1552) was a miraculous, pioneer Roman Catholic missionary of the modern times and co-founder of the Society of Jesus (Jesuit Order). Francis Xavier was born in the castle of Xavier, in the Kingdom of Navarre, (modern Spanish Javier, Basque Xabier) near Sanguesa and Pamplona, in Navarre, Spain. on 7 April 1506 according to a family register. He was thus related to the great theologian and philosopher Martín de Azpilcueta.

At the age of 19, Francis Xavier went to study at the University of Paris, where he received a license e` s arts in 1530. He furthered his studies there in theology and became acquainted with Ignatius Loyola. Along with Ignatius Pierre Favre and four others, Xavier was one of those who on August 15, 1534 bound themselves by a vow at Montmartre and formed the Society of Jesus. Francis Xavier accomplished a great deal of missionary work, both as organizer and as pioneer. On November 21, he fainted after celebrating a mass. He died from a fever at Shangchuan -Island of china on December 02, 1552, at the age of 46, without having reached china, while he was waiting for a boat that would agree to take him to the mainland China.

St. Francis Xavier has requested the foundation of the Goa Inquisition, but he never saw it happen; it commenced eight years after his death. On 16 May 1545 On December 11, 1553, Xavier's body was shipped to Goa. Saint Francis Xavier's relics are kept in a silver casket, elevated inside the Bom Jesus Basilica and are exposed (being brought to ground level) generally every ten years, but this is discretionary. The last exposition was held in 2004 for about one month during December. The next exposition is said to be planned for the year 2014. Bones of Saint Francis Xavier are also found in the Espirito Santo (Holy Spirit) Church, Margão and in Sanv Fransiku Xavierachi Igorz (Church of St. Francis Xavier), Batpal, Canacona, Goa.

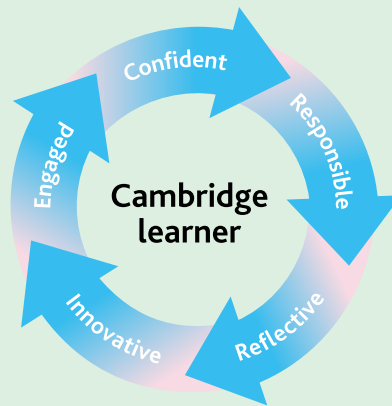

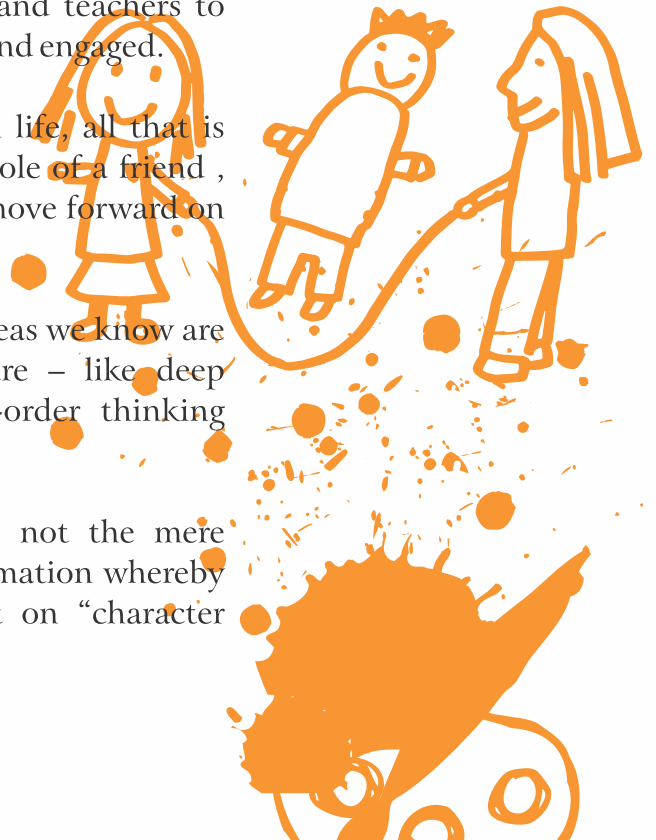

(b) Submit an application addressed to the Principal stating the reasons for changing school

(d) Undertaking to be given by the parents assuring the good conduct and behavior of the ward.

Upper Secondary Std. IX to XII (Eligibility)

(a) Must produce Transfer Certificate (TC) from the school last attended OR Xth Grade Pass certificate

(b) Submit an application addressed to the Principal stating the reasons for changing the school

(c) Written Test to be taken and obtain minimum qualifying marks.

(d) Undertaking to be given by the parents assuring the good conduct and behavior of the ward.

Rules and Regulations



- ★ A STUDENT MUST CARRY HIS/HER DIARY TO SCHOOL EVERY DAY. It must have his/her photograph and complete identity information and signed by parents.
- ★ No parents are allowed to meet the students during the school hours without prior permission and sufficient reason.
- ★ Every student should reach the school at least 10 minutes before the time fixed for Assembly. After the gate is closed no child shall be allowed inside. Parents are requested not to come inside the school campus, when leave / pick up the child.
- ★ Late comers will not be permitted to enter the school, so parents must make arrangements for their ward.
- ★ Students will not be allowed to go home during the school hours.
- ★ Students must come to school neat and tidy, in school uniform and a normal hair cut. Students who are sloppily dressed or not in uniform will be dealt severely. Wearing low waist trousers is prohibited. Girls should plait their hair if it is below the shoulders. Short hair should be neatly cut and pinned. They are allowed to use ONLY BLACK hair bands.
- ★ Students are expected to respect the property of school. No students should damage any furniture, write or draw any thing on walls, furniture or in any way damage things belonging to others. Damage done even by accident should be reported at once to the class teacher or the Principal. Any damage done will be compensated by the one who causes it.
- ★ St. Xavier's Public school provides education from Pre-Nursery to class XI. Therefore it is expected that the juniors will be treated with love and affection, while the juniors show all the respect to their seniors.
- ★ Class time table should be strictly followed and all the students should take care of their textbooks and notebooks. Books should be properly labelled and covered..
- ★ The students are strictly forbidden to purchase any articles of food item from unauthorized vendors near the school premises.
- ★ No collection for any purpose whatsoever is to be started in the school and no meeting, demonstration, party and picnic be held without the previous permission of the Principal.

Rules and Regulations




- ★ Attendance in school is compulsory on all National Festivals Observation days.

Students are responsible to the school authorities for their conduct both in and outside school. Hence,

- ★ misbehaviour, abnormal attitude, legal offences, any reported or observed objectionable conducts is liable to disciplinary action, which may lead to dismissal from school.
- ★ ·All communication should be addressed to the Principal.
- ★ ·Attendance in all the tests is compulsory. Marks of these tests will be counted for award of grade and promotion to next higher class.
- ★ ·TO BE ELIGIBLE TO SIT FOR THE EXAMINATION 75% ATTENDANCE IS COMPULSORY.
- ★ ·Parents are advised to attend the Parents Teacher-Meet (PTM) regularly; this would help them to understand their ward's progress.
- ★ ·STUDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BRING ANY FOOD ITEMS WRAPPED IN PLASTIC. SINGLE USEABLE PLASTIC WATER BOTTLES ARE NOT ALLOWED.
- ★ ·Students are not allowed to bring mobile phones/I pad/camera etc to the school campus. Parents must be aware that if the mentioned items found in their possession will not be given back.

- ★ ·If any student is absent from school, the guardians must send him/her with an absentee record mentioned in Diary.
- ★ ·Rs 50/ will be fined each time for the following reasons: Improper uniform, late coming, Lack of leave, long leave without information etc.
- ★ ·Students should not unnecessarily leave their class at the end of every period.
- ★ Students may wear COLOURFUL DRESS ON HIS/HER BIRTHDAY.
- ★ ·Students using unfair means during examination will face disciplinary action as decided by the school authorities.
- ★ ·Students should obey the orders, directions and instructions given to them by the school authorities time to time. Boys who tease girls shall not be allowed to continue their study in school at any cause.
- ★ ·If a student fails to take the examination when held for any reasons of whatsoever, the same examination will not be conducted in advance/late for the absentees.
- ★ ·Students are strictly discouraged to gift anything to the teachers.
- ★ ·Leave for half day is not encouraged. In case of emergency written permission is must from the parents.
- ★ ·There is no provision for double promotion in school curriculum.

ONLINE CLASSES

We understand that extraordinary circumstances need extraordinary measures. During the pandemic the school has carefully planned a study package for the students. The students were given links which they used to log on to the virtual classroom. Apart from online teaching a video related to the topic and chapter-wise assignments of different subjects we're posted on the class groups. Hence, this way, the students can look forward to being connected virtually. The school has received an overwhelming response from students and parents who look forward each day to new initiatives taken up by the school.





COMPUTER LABS

Well-designed and separate computer labs for different age groups, run by a well-educated and qualified faculty, with one-on-one access, which means there is one computer for each child. Pre – primary kids learn words through PowerPoint presentations and innovative software. The students are introduced with 360 degree computer technology learning under the guidance of a mentor to keep them in sync with the contemporary times.



SCIENCE LABS

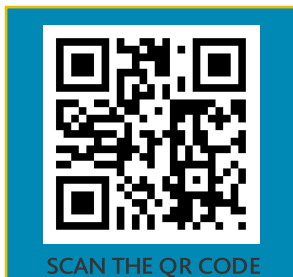
